No person shall address the City Council without first being recognized by the Mayor or the Presiding Officer. All remarks shall be addressed to the City Council as a whole, not to any individual member of the Council, of the audience, or of the City staff. After being recognized by the Mayor or the Presiding Officer, each person shall come to the podium and provide his/her name for the record. Each person has up to five minutes to speak on a specific agenda item or to speak during Public Comment. The time limit may be extended at the discretion of the Mayor or the Presiding Officer. All comments made during the regular meeting on a specific agenda item must pertain to that agenda item. No comments may be made on any other subject. Comments made during the Public Comment period of the agenda may be on any subject. There shall be no personal attacks against the Mayor, members of the City Council, the City staff, or any other individual. No person, other than members of the City Council and the person who has the floor, shall be permitted to enter into any discussion, either directly or through a member of the Council without the permission of the Mayor or Presiding Officer. Questions to City Council members or City staff may not be asked without being recognized by the Mayor or Presiding Officer. Anyone wishing to submit exhibits on any City Council agenda item should make every effort to provide the City Clerk with eight (8) copies of said exhibits in advance of the meeting.
