WATER SHUT-OFF NOTICE

Maintenance Repairs to the Water Distribution System
Tuesday, March 30, 2010

On Tuesday, March 30, 2010 at 8 a.m. water will be shut off at Reese Place and Valley Drive in the Hemenway Valley area, north of Pacifica. This work is necessary in order to replace a large section of a water main.

During this time, you will be unable to use water for any purpose, which includes laundry, showers, or to flush a toilet. The City crew will work as quickly as possible to restore water service, which may *possibly* be off for up to 10 hours.

What to Expect Following a Water Service Shutdown :

When there is a water shutdown, the sediment that naturally occurs in the water piping system is disturbed. This disturbance can cause the water from the faucets and toilets to appear rust colored. You will notice this discoloration when the water service resumes. You may wish to store tap water in your refrigerators on the day of the shutdown or drink bottled water. Once the services return, running your tap will clear the water of rust discoloration.
