Boulder City Council Meetings "On Demand"

Now, anyone with access to a computer is able to watch City Council meetings at their leisure! No matter where you are, simply go to the City's website, www.bcnv.org, and click on the City Council meeting you wish to view at any time of the day or night. Both current and past meetings, beginning with the July 8, 2008, regular meeting, are available.

City Clerk Pamella Malmstrom requested the funds for this "on demand" feature from the City Council several months ago. The members unanimously gave her approval to purchase the equipment, which allows the City Council meetings to be digitally recorded. This feature also posts the agenda minutes from the meetings and viewers can move from item to item if they wish to do so.

Viewers will also be able to watch the video, complete with minutes, of the Redevelopment Agency meetings and the audio and minutes of the Planning Commission meetings. If you wish to view a particular item, that's possible as well. Click on any agenda item and you will be taken to the beginning of that item.

There are a number of ways to click on to "Council Meetings On Demand." From the home page, click the number "5" to the right of the flashing banner. You will be taken to the page where you can choose which meeting you want to view. The meetings are also available on each and every City Council member page as well as on all of the pages in the City Clerk's department.
