Collision at US Hwy 93/95 Interchange

Boulder City Police arrested Amanda M. Werber, 28, during the early morning hours of February 2, and later booked her into the Clark County Detention Center on felony reckless driving, felony driving under the influence, and child endangerment charges. Weber, a Henderson resident, was arrested after a two car collision sent two people to a hospital as a result of the collision.

According to witnesses, a 2006 Pontiac sedan, driven by Werber, was speeding and weaving in and out of traffic while traveling northbound on US Hwy 93 near the US Hwy 95 interchange. The 2006 Pontiac rear-ended a 1986 Pontiac sedan and caused it to roll over onto the right shoulder of the highway. Both occupants of the 1986 Pontiac, the 41-year old male driver and his 24-year old female passenger, both of Las Vegas, were taken to St. Rose Sienna hospital in Henderson with unknown injuries. An 18-month old infant secured in a child seat inside the 2006 Pontiac was uninjured.
