House Fire at Avenue K

At approximately 8:25 p.m. on April 14, 2010, a report of a fire in a structure at 1108 Avenue K was dispatched to the Boulder City Fire Department. En route to the scene, Police Dispatch advised that smoke and flames were coming from the structure and victims may be inside.

The Fire Department immediately activated a third alarm and requested two engine companies from the Henderson Fire Department.

Boulder City Fire Engine 121 and Rescues 121 and 122 arrived on the scene. Engine 121 reported a single story residential structure with smoke showing from the interior and set up operations at the front side of the structure.

Upon entering the structure, the crew found heavy smoke throughout the entire structure and fire in the area of the kitchen. Flames were quickly extinguished and a primary search was conducted. The owners were not home at the time and were not injured; however two pets were lost in the fire.

Engines 81 and 82 and Rescue 82 crews from Henderson aided Boulder City crews in the ventilation and salvage operations at the structure. Fire crews left the scene at approximately 11:30 p.m.

One Boulder City Police Officer was treated at the scene for smoke inhalation.

A fire investigation, which is still ongoing, was conducted by the Boulder City Police Department's fire/arson investigator.
