Two Car Crash on US 93

At approximately 2:03 p.m. on November 26, a Camaro traveling southbound on US 93 crossed the raised median for reasons unknown and collided with a PT Cruiser. Officers cannot say how fast either of the vehicles was traveling.

The driver of the Camaro sustained non-life threatening injuries and was flown to UMC via helicopter.

There were three occupants in the PT Cruiser. A female adult and an 8-year-old were flown to UMC but did not sustain life threatening injuries. The driver of the PT Cruiser was uninjured.

Boulder City Police officers established a landing zone at the scene of the accident so that two helicopters were able to land in the area of US 93 just to the south of the Albertson's store.
