As per the Charter, Section 96, 3(b) If, in the primary City election, a candidate receives votes equal to a majority of voters casting ballots in that election, he shall be considered elected to one of the vacancies and his name shall not be placed on the ballot for the general City election.

The total voters casting ballots were 4,517; therefore, Roger Tobler, Peggy Leavitt and Rod Woodbury were declared elected in the primary election and no general election will be held for those offices. The 2011 general City election will contain six ballot questions for voter consideration.
